



Chilli leaf curl symptoms caused by transmission via aphids  
*Aphis gossypii*, *Myzus persicae*<sup>1</sup>

- Leaf distortion, upward curling



Chilli leaf curl symptoms caused by transmission via mites *Helmitarsonemus latus*<sup>2</sup>

- Downward curling of leaves
- Bronzing of underside of leaves



Chilli leaf curl symptoms caused by transmission via thrips (*Scirtothrips dorsalis*)<sup>3</sup>

- Upward curling of leaf margins
- Brown discoloration on leaves and pods
- Deformation of pods



Chilli leaf curl symptoms caused by transmission via whiteflies (*Bemisia tabaci*)<sup>4</sup>

- Typical boat shape leaves along with mottling
- Rosetting appearance
